Spring 2010 Registration

You can register in person at the Red Oaks Soccer Complex ([for the location click here](#)) on Feb 13, 2010 from 10am to 2pm.

A \$15 late fee will be applied.

Costs:

- Under 6, Under 8, Under 10 = \$40/child + \$15 late fee
- Under 12, Under 14 = \$50/child + \$15 late fee
- Under 16 and up = \$60/child + \$15 late fee
- Uniforms (if needed) = \$35/uniform (yellow & blue jersey, shorts and socks).

Accepting ages 4 to 19.

If you register in person you can pay by check or cash. NO (nada, zip, zilch) CREDIT CARDS. If you want to pay by credit card see the Online Registration section below.
